

A Bylaw of the Town of Esterhazy to provide for the numbering of buildings.

The Council of the Town of Esterhazy enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "Building" shall mean any structure located on a lot or lots in the Town that is used for business or living quarters and includes each section of a business block or multi family dwelling that has a separate front entrance.
 - (b) "Owner" shall mean the registered owner assessed owner, agent leasee or occupier of a building.
 - (c) "Plan" of Numbering for the Town" means a registered plan of subdivision of the Town kept in the office of the Town Clerk containing numbers of buildings situated on lots in such plan of subdivision.
2. Every owner of a building located within the Town shall install on said building at or near the front entrance thereto a number assigned to him by the Town Clerk in accordance with the plan or numbering for the Town, and thereupon said number shall constitute the civic address of said building.
3. IF the owner, after receiving notice from the Town Clerk to install the required number, neglects to do so the Council may install such number at the expence of the owner.
4. ANY person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the Town.
5. THIS BYLAW shall come into force on the 25th day of April A.D. 1964.
